Board Elections

The Meade Activity Center is seeking nominations for one At-Large position to be filled by a Founders Club member to the board of directors. The process for nominations and election is as follows:

October 1-31 - During this period Founders Club Members can submit nominations to the MAC Nominating Committee for consideration of electing an At-Large member to the MAC Board of Directors.

- Founders Club Members may nominate other members, however the person nominated shall indicate in writing their willingness to serve. Nomination forms can be obtained at the MAC office.
- For consideration nominees must complete the questionnaire that can be obtained at the MAC office.

November - A ballot listing the names of the candidates will be sent to each Founders Club Member. (Ballots will only be sent if more than one Founders Club Nomination is received)

December - At the regularly scheduled December meeting the MAC Board of Directors shall open ballots and tally votes.

- The candidate receiving the most votes will be contacted directly by the MAC Board Chairman to inform them of the results. The individual with the most votes will serve a term of two years.

2019 - The newly elected MAC Director will formally take their seat on the Board of Directors at the regularly scheduled first meeting of the year.

River Trace Golf

The golf course has experienced another great summer. We are currently engaged in a new project with the tee boxes. Our Grounds crew has been working on over-seeding the tee boxes and approach areas at the golf course. A new perennial product known commonly as Blue-Muda is being applied that should keep the tees and approaches green all year. Right now the tee boxes have been moved to allow the seed to germinate. Please be mindful and utilize the temporary tee boxes until they are moved back by our staff. (Likely by October 8)

If all goes well we won't have to use temporary/winter tee boxes in the future as a result.

With at least 4-6 weeks of nice fall weather around the corner, we expect to see a high volume of folks out on the course.
