Pool

* Health Department Regulations requires children be 17+ to attend any aquatics facility by themselves. Anyone under 17 must be accompanied by someone 17+.

River Trace Golf

The golf course is moving along nicely this season. Our Bermuda grass fairways are filling in, the greens are healthy, and the tee boxes are doing well with the new hybrid grass we have installed. We were able to get some sod work done last month and also were able to open up all the refinished bunkers on the course.

<u>CART PATH ONLY</u> – If signs are posted for Cart Path Only for a Hole, they mean <u>CART PATH ONLY</u>. Far too frequently we see members and guests off the path on holes 2,5,7,9 even after significant rainfall and multiple signs being posted.

-ALL PAR 3'S ARE CART PATH ONLY ALL YEAR. -HOLE NUMBER 7 SHOULD NEVER HAVE A CART RIDING THE HILL OR IN THE BOTTOM OF THE FAIRWAY -CARTS SHOULD NEVER GET WITHIN 50 FEET OF THE PUTTING GREENS.

River Trace Golf (Cont.)

We do have a couple of important announcements concerning the golf course and policies/mandates that must be followed.

- We cannot allow groups to congregate around the practice green.
- We cannot allow groups to congregate around the driving range. •
- We cannot allow groups to congregate around the pavilion. (PLEASE USE SOCIAL DISTANCING) •
- We cannot allow groups to congregate at all. (If the Tuesday Mens League, Wednesday Ladies Group, Friday Gentlemens League, or any other group needs to determine the status of your game you should do so in the back parking lot and SPREAD OUT !!!)
- We are only allowing one person in the golf shop at a time for any MAC /River Trace transaction
- One Person per rental Cart.
- We will allow members to utilize their autopay whether it be an EFT or CC for daily transactions. •
- Non-Members will need to use a credit or debit card for daily transactions. (NO CASH PAYMENTS)
- Flagsticks being pulled should only be done by players who have disinfectant wipes or sanitizer readily available. (Hands should be cleaned after touching a flagstick.)
- BUNKERS SHALL BE PLAYED LIFT, CLEAN, & PLACE. (No Rakes on Course)
- Anything that has to handed to you will be done by a staff member wearing protective gloves. Keys will be kept in bleach water.
- **GOLF CARTS WILL BE DISENFECTED AFTER EACH USE.**
